Snow Snakes

This winter game is played by sliding snow snakes down a track. The farther the snake slides the higher the reward.

Patrols bring their own snow snakes. Snow snakes are strips of wood or tree branches; about 1 to 2 inches wide, and will be limited to 5 feet in length. The snake may be carved with a head and a tail.

They can be painted to look real or just to be colorful. Make sure to put your name and troop number on the snake. The snakes may be waxed or varnished to slide further.
