- The award is made available annually on the basis of one for each 25 units, or fraction thereof. The District need not present all the awards to which it is entitled each year.
- The Award of Merit is approved by the District Chair upon recommendation of the Selection Committee, and is presented at the Volunteer Recognition Dinner.
- The recipient may receive this award only once.

**Qualifications**

- A candidate must be a registered Scouter.
- A candidate must have rendered noteworthy service to boys at the **District level**.
- The candidate should have contributed some service to youth outside of Scouting.
- Consideration should be given to the candidate's position and the corresponding opportunity to render outstanding service beyond the expectation of duty.
- The candidate's attitude and cooperation with the district and council is to be taken into consideration.
