Black Hills South Dakota 2017

A high adventure trip to the Black Hills of South Dakota is planned for next spring, June 28 to July 5, 2017. This trip is being planned by Troops 159 and 129 from Many Waters District and our district has been invited to join them. This is open to individual Scouts and adults as well. Scouts need to be First Class and 13 years old by the start of the trip. All adult leaders, committee members, and parents are also welcome. Again, you do not need to register as a unit, but can register individually. Additional registration information will be made available this month.

Stops will include, Pipestone, Badlands, Mount Rushmore National Monuments, Crazy Horse, the Air Force Museum, and Wind Cave National Park. The cost has been set at \$400 (a first payment of \$100 will most likely be due this month). This is a camping trip and we will need to bring our own equipment and do most of our own cooking.

This trip is being coordinated with the assistance of Denny Peterson who has organized many such trips. I have worked Denny on many of these trips including 2 historic trails trips to the east coast and the southwestern United States, Galena, Illinois, and 5 National Jamboree trips.
