The Chief Black Dog (GO!) activities committee is looking at 2 new activities. A brief description follows:

**A Klondike Derby.** Not really a new activity, a Klondike Derby was run for many years as part of a larger winter event – Blizzard Fest. Patrols would build a sled and then traverse a course through camp, encountering many challenges along way including preparing a hot lunch. As mentioned, this was part of a larger event called Blizzard Fest. Younger scouts or even Webelos could choose not to build a sled, but rather partake in another series of challenges. Older scouts often built the sleds. How do you feel about reintroducing this activity? The time frame would be the month of February.

**Cub-Anapolis (500).** A summertime Cub Scout event. Dens or individual Cubs would prepare a car made of cardboard or similar material and then race it around a course. There would be periodic pit stops. For example, to change tires, Cub Scouts would change their shoes or socks and continue racing. The proposed time frame would be late June.
